The Washington Trust for Historic Preservation, in association with the National Barn Alliance, is hosting the Heritage Barn Conference to be held at the Marcus Whitman Hotel and Conference Center in Walla Walla on May 6-7, 2010.

The goal for the conference is to gather stakeholders who have an interest in promoting the preservation of heritage barn sites in the Pacific Northwest, including Washington, Oregon, Idaho and beyond. We will be convening preservationists, planners, farm owners, historians, barn aficionados, and the community at large to focus on barn preservation and related topics.

In an effort to encourage attendance from a broad, regional audience throughout the northwest, the Washington Trust for Historic Preservation is offering scholarships to help defray the costs of attending the conference. Scholarships will be awarded to those applicants throughout the region whose attendance will benefit their communities and whose commitment to historic barns specifically and to historic preservation in general will be strengthened by their participation.

Scholarship funds will cover the cost of conference registration. Recipients will also receive a complimentary one-year membership to the Washington Trust for Historic Preservation.

To qualify, scholarship recipients must demonstrate a vested interest in historic barns and/or historic preservation in general, such as:

- Volunteering on preservation-related projects
- Holding a membership/affiliation in a local agricultural related organization, preservation commission, Main Street organization, neighborhood group, or other preservation-related organization; serving the aforementioned in an administrative capacity; or holding a local elected office
- Owning or improving an historic barn or other building
- Focusing college studies on historic preservation, agricultural studies, or a related field

Program Requirements and Important Dates

Scholarship recipients must attend the full day of education sessions.

Deadline for submission of application: March 26, 2010

Notification of scholarship selections: No later than March 31, 2010

Scholarship recipients are responsible for lodging, meals not covered by registration fees, and any other miscellaneous conference costs. More details will be provided to those receiving awards.
